CHAP. 121

#### Chapter 118.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Georgia M. Sproul, of Liberty.

Pension provided for Georgia M. Sproul. Resolved: That a pension of \$15 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Georgia M. Sproul, of Liberty, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Approved March 25, 1933

#### Chapter 119.

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Horatio Lawrence, of Pittston.

Pension provided for Horatio Lawrence. Resolved: That a pension of \$15 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Horatio Lawrence, of Pittston, to be paid from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of the state pension which he is now receiving.

### Chapter 120.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Ida S. James, of Randolph.

Pension provided for Ida S. James. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Ida S. James, of Randolph, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Emma J. Brown, of Belfast.

Pension provided for Emma J. Brown, of Belfast. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Emma J. Brown,
