RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Rufus V. Libby, of Thomaston.

Pension provided for Rufus V. Libby. Resolved: That a pension of \$25 per month be and hereby is, granted to Rufus V. Libby, of Thomaston, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Ida G. Reed, of Pittston.

Pension provided for Ida G. Reed, of Pittston. Resolved: That a pension of \$10 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Ida G. Reed, of Pittston, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions, for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Grace Griffin, of Auburn.

Pension granted to Grace Griffin, of Auburn. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Grace Griffin, of Auburn, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of the state pension which she is now receiving.
