to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of the state pension which she is now receiving.

Chapter 129.

RESOLVE, for State Pension in Favor of Mary Barton Redlon, of Augusta.

Pension provided for Mary Barton Redlon. Resolved: That a pension be and hereby is granted to Mary Barton Redlon, of Augusta, Maine, in the sum of \$20 per month to be paid quarterly from the funds for pensions for soldiers and their dependents. Said pension shall begin on July 1st, 1933, and shall continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Chapter 130.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Alida Jackson, of Waldo.

Pension provided for Alida Jackson. Resolved: That a pension of \$10 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Alida Jackson, of Waldo, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Chapter 131.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Oscar Lund, of East Machias.

Pension provided for Oscar Lund. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Oscar Lund, of East Machias, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Approved March 25, 1933
