CHAP. 142

Chapter 139.

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Kate Bird, of Farmingdale.

Kate Bird; pension for. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Kate Bird, of Farmingdale, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and shall continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of the state pension which she is now receiving.

Chapter 140.

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Hannah C.

McLaughlin, of Farmingdale.

Pension provided for Hannah C. McLaughlin. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Hannah C. McLaughlin, of Farmingdale, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of the state pension which she is now receiving.

Chapter 141.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Fred E. Stevens, of Chelsea.

Pension provided for Fred E. Stevens. Resolved: That a pension of \$15 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Fred E. Stevens, of Chelsea, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Laura Witham; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Laura Witham, of Lisbon, to be paid
