Chapter 146.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Lottie J. Jones, of Washington.

Lottie J. Jones; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Lottie J. Jones of Washington, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Chapter 147.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Arthur P. Sanborn, of West Baldwin.

Pension provided for Arthur P. Sanborn. Resolved: That a pension of \$8 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Arthur P. Sanborn of West Baldwin to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Chapter 148.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for William E. Dill, of Randolph.

William E. Dill; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$10 per month be, and hereby is, granted to William E. Dill, of Randolph, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.
