CHAP. 195

#### Chapter 192.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Hattie Boynton, of Montville.

Pension granted to Hattie Boynton. Resolved: That a pension of \$10 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Hattie Boynton, of Montville, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Approved March 30, 1933

#### Chapter 193.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Valdimir B. Jones, of Waldo.

Pension provided for Valdimir B. Jones. Resolved: That a pension of \$8 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Valdimir B. Jones, of Waldo, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

#### Chapter 194.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Elida F. Whitcomb, of Montville.

Pension provided for Elida F. Whitcomb. Resolved: That a pension of \$8 per month be, and hereby is granted to Elida F. Whitcomb, of Montville, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Veazie to Reimburse Said Town of Veazie for Support of Archie L. Mishio and Family, State Paupers.
