Supplementary to the Resolves passed at the Regular Session

#### Chapter 216.

RESOLVE on the Pay Roll of the Senate.

Pay roll of the senate. Resolved: That there be paid to the members and officers of the senate of the eighty-sixth legislature, for attendance and mileage at the special session of the legislature convened on the fourteenth day of November, nineteen hundred thirty-three, the amounts stated opposite their respective names on a pay roll list certified to the state controller by the secretary of the senate, bearing the approval of committee on appropriations and financial affairs.

Approved November 14, 1933.

#### Chapter 217.

RESOLVE on the Pay Roll of the House of Representatives.

Pay roll of the house of representatives. Resolved: That there be paid to the members and officers of the house of representatives of the eighty-sixth legislature, for attendance and mileage at the special session of the legislature convened on the fourteenth day of November, nineteen hundred thirty-three, the amounts stated opposite their respective names on a pay roll list certified to the state controller by the clerk of the house, bearing the approval of committee on appropriations and financial affairs.
