Chapter 227.

RESOLVE on the Pay Roll of the Senate.

Resolved: That there be paid to the members of the senate of the eighty-sixth legislature, for attendance and mileage at the special session of the legislature convened on the fourth day of December, nineteen hundred thirty-three, the amounts stated opposite their respective names on a pay roll list certified to the state controller by the secretary of the senate.

Chapter 228.

RESOLVE, on the Pay Roll of the House of Representatives.

Resolved: That there be paid to the members of the house of representatives of the 86th legislature, for attendance and mileage at the special session of the legislature convened on the 4th day of December, 1933, the amounts stated opposite their respective names on a pay roll list certified to the state controller by the clerk of the house.
