Supplementary to the Resolves passed at the Regular Session and Special Sessions of November 14, and December 4-20, 1933.

Chapter 230

RESOLVE on the Pay Roll of the House of Representatives.

Pay roll of the house of representatives. Resolved: That there be paid to the members, officers and chaplains of the house of representatives of the eighty-sixth legislature, for attendance and mileage at the special session of the legislature convened on the sixth day of November, nineteen hundred thirty-four, the amounts stated opposite their respective names on a pay roll list certified to the state controller by the clerk of the house, bearing the approval of committee on appropriations and financial affairs.

Chapter 231

RESOLVE on the Pay Roll of the Senate.

Pay roll of the senate. Resolved: That there be paid to the members, officers and chaplains of the senate of the eighty-sixth legislature, for attendance and mileage at the special session of the legislature convened on the sixth day of November, nineteen hundred thirty-four, the amounts stated opposite their respective names on a pay roll list certified to the state controller by the secretary of the senate, bearing the approval of committee on appropriations and financial affairs.
