Supplementary to the Resolves passed at the Regular Session, 1935

Chapter 135

RESOLVE on the Pay Roll of the House of Representatives.

Pay roll of the house of representatives. **Resolved:** That there be paid to the members, officers and chaplains of the house of representatives of the eighty-seventh legislature, for attendance and mileage at the special session of the legislature convened on the sixteenth day of December nineteen hundred thirty-six, the amounts stated opposite their respective names on a pay roll list certified to the state controller by the clerk of the house, bearing the approval of committee on appropriations and financial affairs.

Chapter 136

RESOLVE on the Pay Roll of the Senate.

Pay roll of the senate. **Resolved:** That there be paid to the members, officers and chaplains of the senate of the eighty-seventh legislature, for attendance and mileage at the special session of the legislature convened on the sixteenth day of December, nineteen hundred thirty-six, the amounts stated opposite their respective names on a pay roll list certified to the state controller by the secretary of the senate, bearing the approval of committee on appropriations and financial affairs.
