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## Chapter 21

### AN ACT Relating to Trappers' Licenses.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 38, § 42, amended. Section 42 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words:

'Any person who has been found guilty by the court of breaking and entering, or of larceny, shall not be eligible thereafter to obtain a trapper's license.'
