Chapter 54

RESOLVE, Granting Authority to the Forestry Department to Sell Certain Land.

Forestry department authorized to sell certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to sell the following described lot to the First National Bank of Van Buren for the sum of \$223.33:

Lot 17 containing 130 acres in township 17, Range 5, W. E. L. S., Aroostook county;

Lot 22 containing 92 acres in township 17, Range 5, W. E. L. S., Aroostook county.

Chapter 55

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Hurricane Island.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey state's interest in Hurricane Island. Resolved: That the forest commissioner as land agent be, and hereby is, authorized to convey by a deed of quit claim the interest of the state in Hurricane Island, so-called, in Penobscot Bay, in the county of Knox, to the inhabitants of the town of Vinalhaven.

Chapter 56

RESOLVE, Relating to a Retirement Pension for Burleigh E. Bean, of Waite.

Burleigh E. Bean, made eligible to retirement pension. Resolved: That Burleigh E. Bean, of Waite, a road supervisor in the employ of the state for 14 years, is hereby made eligible to receive a retirement pension under the provisions of sections 227-230 of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933.
