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## Chapter 14

### AN ACT Relating to Carrying Concealed Weapons.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 142, § 14, amended. Section 14 of chapter 142 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 14. Certain officers may issue license. The chief of police or city marshal, ~~or in his absence, any of the captains of police~~ of any city, or the selectmen of any town, may upon written application therefor issue to any ~~person~~ legal resident of such city or town of good moral character, a certificate setting forth that such person has been duly licensed to carry ~~any such~~ ~~any~~ weapon or weapons mentioned in the preceding section. Said license shall continue in effect to the end of the calendar year in which issued and for 1 year thereafter unless sooner ~~until~~ revoked by the chief of police, city marshal, or by the selectmen of the town in which said license was issued.'

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## Chapter 15

### AN ACT Repealing the Law Relating to Chauffeurs' Licenses.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 29, § 36, repealed. Section 36 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 255 of the public laws of 1931, by chapter 277 of the public laws of 1933 and by chapter 53 of the public laws of 1937, is hereby repealed.
