CHAP. 30

Chapter 28

RESOLVE, in Favor of Samuel J. Dana, Representative of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians.

Samuel J. Dana; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Samuel J. Dana, representative of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians at the 89th legislature, the sum of \$200 for attendance and \$44 for mileage; said sums to be paid from the appropriation for legislative expenses.

Approved March 24, 1939.

Chapter 29

RESOLVE, in Favor of Leo Shay, Representative of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Leo Shay, appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be paid to Leo Shay, representative of the Penobscot tribe of Indians at the 89th legislature, the sum of \$200 for attendance, and \$18 for mileage; said sums to be paid from the appropriation for legislative expenses.

Approved March 24, 1939.

Chapter 30

RESOLVE, in Favor of J. E. White, of Columbia.

J. E. White, of Columbia; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$500 to be paid to J. E. White, of Columbia, for extra labor and materials furnished on a contract job on state highway "N," federal aid project 99, section D, in Columbia Falls, this amount to be a settlement in full for all claims against the state of Maine; said sum to be paid from the general highway funds.
