Chapter 58

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Land in Washington County to Edith D. McKenney, of Lincoln.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner as land agent, be and hereby is, authorized to convey to Edith D. McKenney, of Lincoln, the interest of the state in 1 acre lot of land with buildings thereon, in T. 9, R. 4, N. B. P. P. (formerly Forest City) in Washington county, for the sum of \$114.52.

Chapter 59

RESOLVE, for the Laying of the County Taxes for the Year Nineteen Hundred Forty.

County taxes apportioned. Resolved: That the sum annexed to the counties in the following schedule is hereby granted as a tax on each county respectively to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied to the purpose of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same and for other purposes of law, for the year 1940.
