Chapter 80

RESOLVE, in Favor of Edith Given, of Windsor.

Edith Given; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$33 to be paid to Edith Given, of Windsor, as a full and final settlement against the state, for poultry killed by Lauretta Bourassa, a state ward; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

Chapter 81

RESOLVE, in Favor of Joseph Michaud, of Berwick.

Joseph Michaud; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$82.10 as a full and final settlement against the state, to compensate him for hospital and doctors' bills incurred by him in the treatment of his minor son, Henry Michaud, who was wilfully injured by one, Leo Rouselle, a state charge; said sum to be paid from the general funds of the state.

Chapter 82

RESOLVE, in Favor of H. L. Bruen, of Readfield.

H. L. Bruen; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$50, to be paid to H. L. Bruen, of Readfield, as a full and final settlement against the state to compensate him for all damages done to his house, occupied by Beatrice Connor and family, state paupers; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.
