CHAP. 37

#### Chapter 35

AN ACT Relating to the Salary for Clerks in the Office of Clerk of Courts in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of the next to the last paragraph of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary for clerks in the office of clerk of courts in Washington county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$780 \$1,200;'

#### Chapter 36

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of Probate in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 140, § 3, amended. That part of the 2nd paragraph of section 3 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the judge of probate in Washington county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Washington, \$1,200 \$1,500,'
