Chapter 16

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Piscataquis County to Bertha M. Blanchard, of Greenville.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Bertha M. Blanchard, of Greenville, whatever interest the state has in the following described lots, for the sum of \$55.29:
