CHAP. 37

Chapter 35

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Estate of R. Byron Flewelling, Late of West Gardiner, Deceased; for Damage to Property.

Estate of R. Byron Flewelling; compensated for loss of property. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$3,500 to be paid to Adaline B. Flewelling of Gardiner, as administratrix of the Estate of R. Byron Flewelling, late of West Gardiner, deceased, as a full and final settlement against the state, for loss of certain personal property caused by fire, which fire was set by Elgra O. Ryder of Clinton, a minor ward of the state; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

Chapter 36

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Salem for Forest Fire.

Town of Salem; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$547.85, to be paid to the town of Salem to reimburse such town for money expended in extinguishing a forest fire which occurred in August, 1944.

Chapter 37

RESOLVE, for Location of Lookout Station on Picked Mountain in the Town of Clifton, Penobscot County.

Location of lookout station on Picked Mountain, established. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, directed to establish a lookout station on Picked Mountain in the town of Clifton, county of Penobscot.
