CHAP. 60

#### Chapter 58

RESOLVE, Regulating Fly Fishing in Tributaries of Richardson Lake.

Fly fishing in tributaries of Richardson lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening portions of Metalluc brook, Mill brook and Mosquito brook, all tributaries of Upper Richardson lake in Oxford county, to fly fishing only from August 15th to September 30th with a daily bag limit of 4 fish; and be it further

**Resolved:** That the commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to erect proper markers to designate the limits within which such brooks are open to fly fishing.

Effective July 21, 1945

#### Chapter 59

RESOLVE, in Favor of Roy Marshall of Sanford.

Roy Marshall; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$300 to be paid to Roy Marshall, of Sanford, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his chickens and roosters by fox or foxes; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

### Chapter 60

RESOLVE, Relating to Belgrade Stream.

Belgrade stream; open season for fishing extended. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to extend the open season for fishing in Belgrade stream, Kennebec county, to and including September 30th.
