Chapter 119

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the Register of Probate in Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 140, § 22, amended. That part of section 22 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the register of probate in Sagadahoc county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sagadahoc, \$1,200 \$1,500,'

Effective August 13, 1947

Chapter 120

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the County Treasurer of Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 146, amended. That part of section 146 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the county treasurer of Sagadahoc county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sagadahoc, \$700 \$1,200,'

Chapter 121

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the County Attorney of Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 130, amended. That part of section 130 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the county attorney of Washington county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Washington, \$900 \$1,500,'
