## Chapter 201

### AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the County Commissioners for Cumberland County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 79, § 6, amended. That part of section 6 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the county commissioners of Cumberland county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Cumberland, ~~\$1,750~~ \$2,250.'

## Chapter 202

### AN ACT Relating to Salary of Clerk of Courts and Deputy Clerk of Courts of Cumberland County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 79, § 114, amended. Section 114 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended so that the 6th line thereof shall read as follows:

'Cumberland, ~~\$3,400~~ \$3,800; deputy clerk of courts, ~~\$2,300~~ \$3,000.'

## Chapter 203

### AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the County Treasurer and the Deputy Treasurer of Cumberland County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 79, § 146, amended. That part of section 146 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 314 of the public laws of 1945, which relates to the salary of the county treasurer and the deputy treasurer of Cumberland county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Cumberland, ~~\$2,200~~ \$2,700; deputy treasurer, ~~\$1,040~~ \$1,800.'
