Chapter 405

AN ACT Relating to Salary of State Auditor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 16, § 1, amended. The last sentence of section 1 of chapter 16 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'He shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$4,500~~ \$6,000.'
