CHAP. 122

PRIVATE AND SPECIAL, 1947

Chapter 120

AN ACT Relating to Term of Office of Police Department of the City of Bangor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1933, c. 92, § 4, additional. Chapter 92 of the private and special laws of 1933 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 4, to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 4. Limitation. Any member of the Bangor police department, who joins the employees' retirement system of the state of Maine, shall not be eligible to any benefits provided in this chapter.'

Chapter 121

AN ACT Relating to Pensions to Employees of the City of Bangor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1915, c. 66, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 66 of the private and special laws of 1915, as amended by section 1 of chapter 99 of the private and special laws of 1923, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof, the following:

'The provisions of this section shall not apply to any employee of the said city of Bangor who elects to participate in the employees' retirement system of the state of Maine.'

Chapter 122

AN ACT Relating to Police Department Pensions of the City of Bangor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1921, c. 25, amended. The provisions of chapter 25 of the private and special laws of 1921, as relates to police department pensions of the city of Bangor, shall not apply to any member of said police department who elects to join and who shall join the employees' retirement system of the state of Maine.
