Chapter 11

RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Aroostook County to Woodbury L. Berce, of Washburn.

State tax assessor authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Woodbury L. Berce, of Washburn, whatever interest the state has in lot 11, and 14 acres in N. E. corner of E. $\frac{1}{2}$ Lot 10 N. $\frac{1}{2}$ according to plan by Joseph Sewall in 1886 in T. 17, R. 4, W. E. L. S. Aroostook county, containing 14 acres more or less, for the sum of \$24.53.

Chapter 12

RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Aroostook County to Sylvio Guerette, of Guerette.

State tax assessor authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Sylvio Guerette, of Guerette, whatever interest the state has in part of settlers' lot C. according to plan by E. Hanson recorded in Aroostook registry, northern district, vol. 106, page 557, with buildings, in township 17 R. 5 W. E. L. S. Aroostook county, containing 12 acres more or less, for the sum of \$147.11.

Chapter 13

RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Washington County to Harvey F. Sprague, of Dennysville.

State tax assessor authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Harvey F. Sprague, of Dennysville, whatever interest the state has in a lot bounded N. by Preston Road, E. by Melvin Hayward, S. by Walter Smith Heirs, W. by John Preston, with buildings, in Edmunds Township, Washington county, containing 2 acres, more or less, for the sum of \$25.
