Secretary of state shall prepare ballots. Resolved: That the secretary of state shall prepare and furnish to the several cities, towns and plantations, ballots and blank returns in conformity with the foregoing resolve accompanied by a copy thereof.

Chapter 38

RESOLVE, Opening Northeast Pond in the Town of Hartford to Ice Fishing.

Northeast pond opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Northeast pond in the town of Hartford, Oxford county, to ice fishing.

Chapter 39

RESOLVE, Establishing the Opening Date for Open Water Fishing in Somerset County.

Establishing the opening date for open water fishing in Somerset county. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing the opening time for open water fishing in Somerset county to be as soon as the ice is out after March 31st each year.

Chapter 40

RESOLVE, Abolishing Commission for Promotion of International Good Will in Education.

Resolves, 1939, c. 44, repealed. Resolved: Chapter 44 of the resolves of 1939 is hereby repealed.
