AN ACT Relating to Salary of Register of Probate in Kennebec County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 140, § 22, amended. That part of section 22 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 319 of the public laws of 1945, which relates to the salary of the register of probate in Kennebec county, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Kennebec, ~~\$2,200~~ \$2,300.'

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### Chapter 177

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Register of Probate of York County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 140, § 22, amended. That part of section 22 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the register of probate of York county, as amended by chapter 306 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'York, ~~\$2,400~~ \$2,500.'

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### Chapter 178

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Sheriff of Lincoln County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 79, § 165, amended. That part of section 165 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the sheriff of Lincoln county, as amended by section 4 of chapter 154 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln, ~~\$1,500~~ \$1,800.'
