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## Private and Special Laws

OF THE

### STATE OF MAINE

As Passed by the Ninety-fourth Legislature

1949

'No such officer or employee except a policeman or fireman shall accept or receive from any person, firm or corporation acting under a franchise or license from the city, any frank, free pass, free ticket, or free service, or accept, directly or indirectly, from any such person, firm or corporation, any service upon terms more favorable than those granted to the public generally.'

Effective August 6, 1949

#### Chapter 139

AN ACT Relating to Pensions for Members of the Police Department of the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 25, amended. Section 25 of Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as repealed and replaced by section 11 of chapter 86 of the private and special laws of 1943, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 25. Petition for retirement. Any member of the police department who has served not less than 25 years shall be retired on his petition, and thereupon become entitled to a pension equal to ½ of the pay which such member received at the time of his retirement. Any special patrolman of the department who has served continuously with pay until his regular appointment shall be given credit for such time served towards his retirement.'

#### Chapter 140

AN ACT to Incorporate the Town of Gorham School District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Incorporation; name; purposes. Subject to the provisions of sections 8 and 9 hereof, the inhabitants of and the territory within the town of Gorham are hereby created a body politic and corporate under the name of "Town of Gorham School District" for the purpose of acquiring land for school purposes and purposes incidental thereto, including playgrounds
