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Chapter 1

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Medway

Town of Medway; appropriation for. Resolved: That the balance of the money appropriated in favor of the town of Medway by the 93rd legislature for the fiscal year 1947-48 for repairing and planking the floor of the West Branch Penobscot bridge, so called, be and hereby is reappropriated in favor of the town of Medway to be expended for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950, to aid in resurfacing the Powersville road, so called, starting near the residence of Everett Hale and proceeding north to end of road.

Chapter 2

**RESOLVE, Relating to Fly Fishing in Stratton Brook in Coplin
Plantation, in Franklin County.**

Fly fishing in Stratton brook; regulated. Resolved: That that part of chapter 139 of the resolves of 1947 which relates to Stratton brook as follows: "Stratton brook above dam in Stratton village and tributaries" be, and hereby is, repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Stratton brook above Ed Hinds' bridge, so called, in Coplin plantation.'
