CHAP. 41

RESOLVES, 1949

Chapter 39

RESOLVE, to Repeal State Pension for Joseph Duperry of Fairfield.

Joseph Duperry; state pension repealed. Resolved: That part of chapter 154 of the resolves of 1947, which provides for a state pension for Joseph Duperry of Van Buren, is hereby repealed.

Effective August 6, 1949

Chapter 40

RESOLVE, in Favor of Procuring Testimonials for the Purpose of Marking the Unmarked Graves of the Soldiers of the Revolutionary War.

Marking of graves of soldiers of the Revolutionary War; appropriation. Resolved: That the sum of \$200 be, and hereby is, appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950, for the purpose of procuring testimonials to be used in marking the unmarked graves of the soldiers of the Revolutionary War; and be it further

Resolved: With the approval of the governor and council, said sum shall be paid into the treasury of the "Sons of the American Revolution", with which they are hereby authorized to procure and distribute such number of markers as may, from time to time, be required for the purposes herein specified.

Chapter 41

RESOLVE in Favor of the Maine Historical Society.

Maine Historical Society; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the Maine Historical Society the sum of \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950 and the sum of \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951; the same to be paid in quarterly payments commencing on October 1, 1949.
