### Chapter 55

#### RESOLVE Regulating Fishing in Hayden Lake, in the County of Somerset.

Regulating fishing in Hayden lake, in the county of Somerset. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation extending the closed season on white perch in Hayden lake, in the town of Madison, in the county of Somerset, until June 21st of each year.

### Chapter 56

#### RESOLVE Reducing the Daily Bag Limit on Trout, in the County of Aroostook.

Reducing the daily bag limit on trout, in the county of Aroostook. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation reducing the daily bag limit on trout in the county of Aroostook to not more than 15 fish per person per day.

Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Rocky pond in the town of Rockport and Johnson pond in the town of Appleton, both in Knox county, to ice fishing.
