Chapter 111

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of New Portland.

Town of New Portland; appropriation for. Resolved: That the money appropriated in favor of the town of New Portland by the 93rd legislature for the fiscal years 1947-48 and 1948-49 for repairing the Wire Bridge road, so called, leading from West New Portland to Stanley Perkins' corner, so called, be and hereby is reappropriated for repairing the George Safford road, so called, to be expended for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950.

Effective August 6, 1949

Chapter 112

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Athens.

Town of Athens; reappropriation of money. Resolved: That the sum of \$400 appropriated in favor of the town of Athens by the 93rd legislature for the repairing of the road known as Set Off be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended in the ensuing fiscal years on the Stickney Hill, so called.

Effective August 6, 1949

Chapter 113

RESOLVE, in Favor of Alfred M. Joyce of Brooklin.

Alfred M. Joyce; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund in favor of Alfred M. Joyce of Brooklin the sum of \$132 in full and final settlement of claim against the state for a certain check which was never cashed.

Chapter 114

RESOLVE, in Favor of Caswell Plantation.

Caswell plantation; appropriation for. Resolved: That the money appropriated in favor of Caswell plantation by the 93rd legislature for the repair of the Richardson road, so called; work to begin where work ended under previous special resolve be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended during the fiscal years ending June 30, 1950 and June 30, 1951, as follows:
