### Chapter 137

**RESOLVE**, Providing for a Fish Screen in Molunkus Lake.

Molunkus lake; screening of. **Resolved:** That the sum of \$400 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, for installing a fish screen in Molunkus lake, Aroostook county; provided, however, that the Molunkus Rod and Gun Club shall assume all liability for maintaining said screen and keeping of said screen free from all sticks, leaves and debris so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same, and provided further that the state shall be liable for only  $\frac{1}{2}$  the cost of said screen.

### Chapter 138

**RESOLVE**, Authorizing the Deer Isle-Sedgwick Bridge District to Release Certain Rights to Eunice Winslow of Rockland.

Deer Isle-Sedgwick Bridge District authorized to release certain rights. **Resolved:** That the Deer Isle-Sedgwick Bridge District be, and hereby is, authorized to release to Eunice Winslow of Rockland all of its rights and interest in a certain parcel of land located in Little Deer Isle and taken by the bridge district from Jeremiah W. Eaton by eminent domain procedure and recorded on October 20, 1936, which land was part of the lands taken by the bridge district for an approach to the Deer Isle-Sedgwick bridge and which was later abandoned in favor of another location.

**RESOLVE** Providing for Completion of Medical and Surgical Building at the Augusta State Hospital.

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, present facilities for surgery at this institution are inadequate and inconveniently located at scattered locations and should be brought together in a central unit equally accessible to both the male and female sides of the institution, and
