CHAP, 141

#### Chapter 138

RESOLVE, in Favor of Henry J. Deabay, of Ashland.

Henry J. Deabay; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$300 from the general fund to be paid to Henry J. Deabay, of Ashland, to compensate him for 29 days' service as field artillery officer in the National Guard.

#### Chapter 139

RESOLVE, in Favor of Leon C. Roberts and Sons, of Winthrop.

Leon C. Roberts & Sons; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, paid to Leon C. Roberts & Sons, Winthrop, from the general fund of the state the sum of \$100 as reimbursement for the funeral expenses of Albert E. Houghton.

#### Chapter 140

RESOLVE, in Favor of Clyde Moores, of Springfield.

Clyde Moores; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$171.71 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Clyde Moores, of Springfield, to reimburse him for supplies furnished state paupers; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

### Chapter 141

RESOLVE, in Favor of Dr. Bernard R. Marcus of Auburn.

Dr. Bernard R. Marcus; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund, the sum of \$184, to be paid to Dr. Bernard R. Marcus of Auburn, being the full balance due for dental services performed by him for Constance Ouellette, dependent child of Mrs. Anna C. Ouellette of Lisbon.
