Chapter 30

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Pitcher Pond, Waldo County.

Pitcher Pond; regulating fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation that there shall be no minimum length or bag limit on the taking of black bass in Pitcher Pond, in the Towns of Lincolnville and Northport, Waldo County.

Effective September 12, 1959

Chapter 31

RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing in Kingdom Bog, Waldo County.

Kingdom Bog; regulating ice fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Kingdom Bog in Montville, Waldo County, to ice fishing for pickerel, white perch, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time the ice forms in the fall until March 31st and to ice fishing for all fish, except black bass, from February 1st to March 31st.

Effective September 12, 1959

Chapter 32

RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing in Echo Pond, Kennebec County.

Echo Pond; regulating ice fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Echo Pond in Readfield, Fayette and Mt. Vernon, Kennebec County, to ice fishing for pickerel, white perch, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time the ice forms in the fall until March 31st and to ice fishing for all fish, except black bass, from February 1st to March 31st.

Effective September 12, 1959

Chapter 33

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in North Pond, Town of Sumner, Oxford County.

Fishing in North Pond, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing North Pond, in the Town of Sumner, Oxford County, to ice fishing and to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of 5 trout in said North Pond.
