Chapter 123

RESOLVE, Providing Retirement Benefit Increase for Miles McLaughlin of Augusta.

Miles McLaughlin; retirement benefit increased. Resolved: That the retirement benefit now being paid to Miles McLaughlin of Augusta, be increased from \$60 per month to \$80 per month.

Effective September 12, 1959

Chapter 124

RESOLVE, Providing for Retirement Benefit Increase for Mary E. C. Bridgham of Jonesboro.

Mary E. C. Bridgham; retirement benefit increased. Resolved: That the retirement benefit now being paid to Mary E. C. Bridgham of Jonesboro, under the provisions of the Revised Statutes, chapter 63-A, be increased from \$5.73 monthly to \$25 monthly.

Effective September 12, 1959

Chapter 125

RESOLVE, Providing Retirement Benefit Increase for Carrie M. Longfellow of Machias.

Carrie M. Longfellow; retirement benefit increased. Resolved: That the retirement benefit now being paid to Carrie M. Longfellow of Machias, under the provisions of the Revised Statutes, chapter 63-A, be increased from \$56.86 per month to \$80 per month.

Chapter 126

RESOLVE, Providing a Pension for Miss Avis Robertson of Belfast.

Avis Robertson; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$60 per month be, and is, granted to Miss Avis Robertson, of Belfast, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1959, and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.
