RESOLVES, 1961

CHAP. 85

Limerick, one Representative; Hollis and Buxton, one Representative; Lyman, Dayton, Arundel and Alfred, one Representative; Acton, Newfield, Waterboro and Shapleigh, one Representative.

Effective September 16, 1961

#### Chapter 82

RESOLVE, in Favor of Wayne Innis of Bath.

Money appropriated to Wayne Innis. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$272 to be paid to Wayne Innis of Bath as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for head injuries sustained by his son in January, 1960, caused by a child residing at the Military and Naval Children's Home, which child is under guardianship of the Department of Mental Health and Corrections.

Effective September 16, 1961

#### Chapter 83

RESOLVE, Increasing Pension of Maurice Albert of Madawaska.

Maurice Albert; pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$30 per month is granted to Maurice Albert, of Madawaska, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1961 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

That part of the resolves of 1953, chapter 94, which provided for a state pension for Maurice Albert, of Madawaska, is repealed.

Effective September 16, 1961

#### Chapter 84

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Clyde P. Walker of Stratton.

Clyde P. Walker; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$25 per month is granted to Clyde P. Walker, of Stratton, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1961 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

Effective September 16, 1961

#### Chapter 85

RESOLVE, in Favor of Charles A. Dean Memorial Hospital of Greenville.

Charles A. Dean Memorial Hospital; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
