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**RESOLVES, 1961****CHAP. 92**

Revised Statutes, chapter 63-A, be increased by the amount of \$25 per month, effective as of January 1, 1961.

Effective September 16, 1961

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**Chapter 90****RESOLVE, In Favor of Elude Cantara of Biddeford.**

**Elude Cantara; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$5,000 to be paid to Elude Cantara, a/k/a John Elude Cantara of Biddeford, Maine, to reimburse him for money paid by him to the State of Maine for the support of a grandchild under an erroneous decree and order issued by the municipal court of the City of Biddeford, within and for the County of York and State of Maine, at the request of the Maine State Department of Health and Welfare, and for illegal arrest and incarceration in the county jail in and for the County of York.

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**Chapter 91****RESOLVE, Increasing Pension of Merle Merrill of Montville.**

**State Pension, increased. Resolved:** That a pension of \$65 per month is granted to Merle Merrill, of Montville, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1961 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

That part of the resolves of 1953, chapter 94 which provided for a state pension for Merle Merrill, of Montville, is repealed.

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**Chapter 92****RESOLVE, Increasing State Pension for Mrs. Katie Libby of Charleston.**

**Mrs. Katie Libby; state pension. Resolved:** That a pension of \$60 per month be granted to Katie Libby, of Charleston, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1961, and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

That part of the resolves of 1957, chapter 123, which provided for a state pension for Katie Libby, of Charleston, is repealed.
