PUBLIC LAWS, 1963

Chapter 42

AN ACT to Repeal the Dry Bean Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 16, §§ 282 293, repealed. Sections 282 to 293 of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 326 of the public laws of 1957, are repealed.
- Sec. 2. Disposition of unexpended balance of dry bean tax. Any unexpended balance of the dry bean tax as of the effective date of this act is transferred to the Department of Agriculture to be expended for fostering and promoting better methods of production, merchandising and advertising of the dry bean industry of this State.

Chapter 43

AN ACT Relating to Meaning of Letters Used in State Valuation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 16, § 80, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 80 of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The letters "W. E. L. S." West of the East Line of the State; "B. K. P." Bingham's Kennebec Purchase; "B. P. P." Bingham's Penobscot Purchase; "N. B. P. P." North of Bingham's Penobscot Purchase; "W. B. K. P." West of Bingham's Kennebec Purchase; "N. B. K. P." North of Bingham's Kennebec Purchase; "W. K. R." West of the Kennebec River; "E. K. R." East of the Kennebec River; "E. C. R." East of the Canada Road; "W. C. R." West of the Canada Road; "N. W. P." North of Waldo Patent; "T. S." Titcomb Survey; "E. D." East Division; "M. D." Middle Division; "N. D." North Division; "S. D." South Division.'
