CHAP. 392

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Insurance Department the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to print copies of the rules and regulations adopted under this act and to make them available to those interested, the breakdown of which shall be as follows:

#### Chapter 391

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Justices of Supreme Judicial Court and Superior Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 103, § 4, amended. The first sentence of section 4 of chapter 103 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 370 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

The Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court shall each receive an annual salary of \$14,000 \$17,000, and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court shall receive an annual salary of \$15,000 \$18,000.

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 106, § 2, amended. The first sentence of section 2 of chapter 106 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by section 68 of chapter 378 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

'Each of the Justices of the Superior Court shall receive an annual salary of \$13,500 \$16,500.'

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$37,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and the sum of \$45,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to carry out the purposes of this act.

### Chapter 392

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Official Court Reporters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 113, § 188, amended. The first sentence of section 188 of chapter 113 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 380 of the public laws of 1957, and chapter 368 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:
