Chapter 39

AN ACT Exempting Firemen from Waiting Period Under Workmen's Compensation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 39, § 53, amended. Section 53 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘§ 53. Waiting period; when compensation payable

No compensation for incapacity to work shall be payable for the first 7 days of incapacity, **except that firemen shall receive compensation from the date of incapacity.** In case incapacity continues for more than 21 days, compensation shall be allowed from the date of incapacity.’

Effective September 3, 1965

Chapter 40

AN ACT Relating to Boxing and Prize Fights.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 17, § 551, amended. Section 551 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘This section shall not apply to any boxing contest or exhibition conducted by license and permit of the Maine State Boxing Commission.’

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 17, § 552, repealed. Section 552 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.

Chapter 41

AN ACT Providing for Coverage of Employees of Maine State Employees Association and Maine State Employees Credit Union Under State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 1092, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 1092 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘1. **Participating local districts.** The employees of any county, city, town, water district, public library corporation or any other quasi-municipal corpora-
