**Sec. 2. R. S., T. 34, § 2333, amended.** The last paragraph of section 2333 of Title 34 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Such a certificate, upon endorsement for such purpose by a **judge of probate**, the District Court Judge or complaint justice within whose jurisdiction the individual is present, **or by a Justice of the Superior Court**, shall authorize any health or police officer to take the individual into custody and transport him to a hospital as designated in the application.'

## Chapter 152

**AN ACT Relating to Adequate Brakes on Truck Tractors and Semitrailers.**

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

**R. S., T. 29, § 1652, amended.** The last sentence of section 1652 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'All trucks and combinations of truck tractor and semitrailer with 4 or more axles shall have adequate brakes on the wheels of all axles; **except that this sentence shall not apply if the vehicle is in compliance with Interstate Commerce Commission safety regulations.**'

## Chapter 153

**AN ACT Classifying Collier Brook, Cumberland County.**

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

**R. S., T. 38, § 369, sub-§ 6-A, additional.** That part which relates to Cumberland County of section 369 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 6-A, to read as follows:

'6-A. Gray.

**AN ACT Relating to Procedure for Registration of Voters.**

**R. S., T. 21, § 102-A, additional.** Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 102-A, to read as follows:
