Sec. 2. Duties. The committee shall study the feasibility of and the recreational needs for a bridge and causeway to Chebeague Island, Cumberland County.

Sec. 3. Report. The committee shall report the result of its study to the 103rd Legislature.

Chapter 145

AN ACT Relating to Organization of Lewiston Fire Department.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XII, § 4, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 4 of article XII of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as last amended by section 2 of chapter 170 of the private and special laws of 1951, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'They may also appoint such fire inspectors as are deemed necessary, direct the organization of a Fire Prevention Bureau and appoint such clerks and assistants which are necessary for the administration and functions of the department. Compensation for the above individuals shall be subject to the approval of the board of finance.'

Chapter 146

AN ACT Relating to Chairman and Membership of Board of Finance of City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. VIII, § 1, repealed and replaced. Section 1 of article VIII of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 1. Members of board of finance. The board of finance shall consist of 4 members to be appointed by the mayor for a term of 4 years. No successor will be appointed by the mayor of the finance board member whose term expires in 1965.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. VIII, § 3, repealed and replaced. Section 3 of article VIII of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 3. Chairman. The mayor shall be ex officio the chairman of the board of finance and the authority of said mayor to act and vote shall be coextensive with the 4 other members of said board of finance.'
