Chapter 179

AN ACT Appropriating Moneys for Study of Maine Motor Vehicle Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Study. The Secretary of State is authorized to study the present provisions of the Maine motor vehicle laws in comparison with the Uniform Vehicle Code and to report to the next regular session of the Legislature such changes and amendments as may be necessary or desirable to make the Maine motor vehicle laws more understandable, workable and useful.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$2,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 to carry out the purposes of this Act. Said sum shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1967.

Chapter 180

AN ACT Appropriating Moneys to Supplement Loans by Maine School Building Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Maine School Building Authority appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$25,000 to the Maine School Building Authority, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 for the purpose of providing grants to municipalities to supplement lease-rental agreements for construction of needed classroom facilities. This appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1967.
