Sec. 6. Report. The commission shall report its progress to the Governor and to the 103rd Legislature, or, if requested by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House to any special session of the 102nd Legislature held after January 1, 1966, with any recommendations which it sees fit to make concerning transportation in the State.

Sec. 7. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the State the sum of \$35,000 to the State Transportation Commission to carry out the purposes of this Act. Such appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.

Chapter 189

AN ACT Providing Funds for Municipal Building at Old Orchard Beach.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Funds. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$100,000 to the Town of Old Orchard Beach, to aid in the construction of a municipal building, including an auditorium. Such appropriation shall not be available until a like amount has been realized from voluntary subscriptions or land equivalent in value provided by the Town of Old Orchard Beach.

Chapter 190

AN ACT Providing Funds for Accelerated Program for the University of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Funds for accelerated program for University of Maine. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$489,025 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$390,975 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to the University of Maine to carry out the accelerated program for the University. The breakdown shall be as follows:
