Effective September 3, 1965

Chapter 61

RESOLVE, to Permit Howard G. Richardson, Readfield, Use of His Out-of-State Credits to Obtain a Retirement Allowance.

Howard G. Richardson use of his out-of-state credits. Resolved: That the Maine State Retirement System is directed to permit Howard G. Richardson, Readfield, to apply for a retirement allowance and in the computation thereof shall include that out-of-state service for which he has paid contributions and for which he would be credited upon completion of 20 years of service within the State.

Effective September 3, 1965

Chapter 62

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Search of Lost Persons in the Woodlands of the State.

Reimburse Department of Inland Fisheries and Game for money spent to find lost persons. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game the sum of \$3,612.40 to reimburse the department for expenses incurred during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 for attempting to find lost persons in the woodlands of the State.

Effective September 3, 1965

Chapter 63

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Town of Hanover for Aid Extended Floyd Merrill.

Town of Hanover; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$300 to be paid to the Town of Hanover to reimburse the town for support of Floyd Merrill.

Effective September 3, 1965

Chapter 64

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Hotel Rumford for Additional Payment for Hotel Liquor License.

Hotel Rumford; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated the sum of \$300 from funds of the Liquor Commission to be paid to the Hotel Rumford,
