CHAP. 55

It shall be lawful to take suckers in all rivers, brooks and streams which are open to fishing between April 15th 1st and May June 30th of each calendar year by the use of a hand spear by persons licensed or otherwise entitled to fish in Maine waters.

Chapter 53

AN ACT Establishing American History Month in Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. I, § II3, additional. Title I of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section II3 to read as follows:

§ 113. American History Month

The month of February of each year is designated as American History Month and the Governor of the State of Maine shall annually issue a proclamation inviting and urging the people of the State of Maine to observe the month of February as such in schools and other suitable places with appropriate ceremony and activity.

Chapter 54

AN ACT Permitting the Removal of Disabled Motor Vehicles for Repair.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 244, amended. The 4th paragraph from the end of section 244 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

No motor vehicle, or combination of motor vehicle and trailer or semitrailer, except fire department vehicles and disabled motor vehicles being towed to a repair facility, shall exceed in length 55 feet overall including all structural parts thereof, permanent or temporary, and any load carried thereon or therein.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 37, § 101, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 101 of Title 37 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
