CHANGING NAME OF STEVENS TRAINING CENTER 369 PUBLIC LAWS, 1967 CHAP. 195

Chapter 193

AN ACT Prohibiting Hunting Deer with Certain Firearms.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2458-A, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new section 2458-A, to read as follows:

§ 2458-A. Hunting deer with certain weapons

It is unlawful to hunt deer with any firearm using the .22 cal. rim fire cartridge, but not including the .22 cal. rim fire magnum.

Chapter 194

AN ACT Providing for Assistant Superintendent at Stevens Training Center.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 15, § 2712, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 2712 of Title 15 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The Superintendent Superintendents of the Boys Training Center Training Centers shall have assistant superintendents to be appointed by him each of said superintendents, subject to the Personnel Law, who, when the office of superintendent is vacant, or the superintendent is absent from the center or unable to perform the duties of his the office, shall have the powers, perform the duties and be subject to all the obligations and liabilities of the superintendent.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 15, § 2611, sub-§ 4, ¶ B, amended. Paragraph B of subsection 4 of section 2611 of Title 15 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

B. Commit to the Boys Training Center or the Stevens Training Center School, if the juvenile is of the proper age;
