CHAP. 72

RESOLVES, 1967

Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$500 for the purpose of this resolve.

Effective October 7, 1967

Chapter 70

RESOLVE, Reimbursing Mars Hill Utility District for Bonds Issued for Sewer Construction.

Mars Hill Utility District; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$28,738 to be paid to the Mars Hill Utility District to be held and used by said district solely for the purpose of paying the principal and interest on certain Sewer Construction Serial and Term Bonds issued by said district in 1964.

Effective October 7, 1967

Chapter 71

RESOLVE, Increasing Pension for Leeman Grant of Milbridge.

Leeman Grant; state pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$100 per month is granted to Leeman Grant of Milbridge (formerly of Columbia Falls), to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1967 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

That part of the resolves of 1943, chapter 59, which provided for a state pension for Leeman Grant, of Columbia Falls, is repealed.

Effective October 7, 1967

Chapter 72

RESOLVE, Providing Funds to the Washington County Development Authority for Development of Recreational Areas.

Washington County Development Authority, appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$5,000 to be paid to the Washington County Development Authority for completing and improving the public landing on Cathance Lake and adjacent camping sites, recreational areas and approaches in the Town of Cooper, Washington County.
