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## Chapter 107

### AN ACT Repealing Law Providing for ~~Economic~~ and Recreational Development in Oxford County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., T. 10, § 911, repealed. Section 911 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 122 of the public laws of 1965 and amended by sections 1 and 2 of chapter 442 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed.

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## Chapter 108

### AN ACT Relating to Inspection of Motorcycles.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., T. 29, § 2122, amended. The last sentence of the 4th paragraph of section 2122 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as follows:

~~Said inspection shall not apply to motorcycles.~~

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## Chapter 109

### AN ACT Relating to the Preparation of Voting Lists.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 21, § 171, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 171 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

1. **List prepared.** He shall prepare a printed or typewritten list, alphabetically by surname, of all the voters of the municipality. **He shall add the street address of each voter beside his name and mailing address.** In a municipality which has voting districts, he shall make a separate list for each district ~~and shall add the street address of each voter beside his name.~~

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 21, § 201, sub-§ 1, ¶ B, amended. Paragraph B of subsection 1 of section 201 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

B. Street address and mailing address.

Sec. 3. **Effective date.** This Act shall take effect on April 1, 1970.
